SRE (Scripture) is an amazing ministry and an incredible opportunity to engage children and young people with the Christian faith. We are excited you are starting your journey as an SRE helper and to join the statewide SRE team! The helper role is a valued role offering support to an SRE teacher Here are some easy steps towards being part of this wonderful and unique ministry!

JOIN THE TEAM

We recommend you visit an SRE lesson so that you can see for yourself just how amazing SRE is. All you need is a current WWCC number and a covering letter from the SRE team at the Baptist Association.



All SRE representatives must have a valid Working with Children Check Number (WWCC) as well as completing the Baptist Association's Creating Safe Spaces training (CSS). This training is completed in two parts- online + workshop. Complete Part 1 online and Part 2 via zoom/face to face. This is renewed every 3-4 years. The Department of Education also strongly encourages SRE teachers to complete their annual child protection course which is free and accessed online.

COMPLIANCE & DOCUMENTATION

Before you start the next stage of SRE specific training, we ask you have a more formal chat with your *Pastor about what is required. They will complete a Pastor **Endorsement Form** and you will complete the Baptist Association's **Code of** Conduct & Screening Questionnaire & DoE Declaration . We also ask you to read the Association's related policies and procedures.

SRE MODULE TRAINING

Complete three Modules from our SRE Teacher Training Course. These can be completed online via **Essentials Modules One**, Four & Seven or on zoom or face to face (subject to availability). For available dates check our website. Our SRE team can also provide information on upcoming training available.

APPLICATION FORM

Complete our **online application form**. Once the processing of your application is complete, you will receive an email notification with a letter to teach. You will also receive an authorisation card, first sent to your church for your *Pastor to sign and then hand to you. Your card is valid for 3 years.

Please note, if you attend a non-Baptist Church and seeking authorisation through us, you must contact us before you start the process as we have conditions on this arrangement.
