Moore's Interactive Conflict Causes

Five Potential Contributors to Conflict

All conflict is complex and the following five factors identified by Christopher Moore often interact with each other

- 1. There can be issues over the relevance, importance, interpretation and meaning of factual and information related to the conflict.
- 2. Issues to do with the structure, rules, system and authority lines in the context where the conflict exists.
- 3. Issues created by the personal implications of the conflict, the costs and benefits potential outcomes, personal interests that the conflict impacts.
- 4. Issues created from the status of the past and present interpersonal relationship between parties.
- 5. Issues that arise from different worldviews, values and beliefs which are deeply held and important to parties.
