<b>Bible Explored</b> <b>(Three16 Shoalhaven)</b>	Stage 4 & 5 - years 7-10.	8-10 lessons per term for each year group.	The curriculum provides a framework, outline and rational for the SRE lessons. Each teacher must then build their lessons accordingly.	Big picture lesson outlines are mapped out. This curriculum does not include PowerPoint, lesson plans or worksheets.	A useful curriculum as a framework of teaching content across year 7-10. SRE teachers would need to spend considerable time building out their lessons. <b>CCSM</b> <b>(Coffs Coast Schools Ministry)</b>	Stage 4 Year 7 & 8	5 lessons per term. This curriculum works best with fortnightly lessons.	The first 2 terms of work for year seven covers what CCSM calls 'Basic Christianity. All lessons have students interacting with the scriptures connected with the worksheets. A4 in size and often 2 – 4 pages.	PowerPoint slides are not included. Lesson plans with worksheets are included.	CCSC captures well some of the big picture teachings of the Christian faith. Useful for schools operating on a fortnightly basis. Also useful for those environments where a projector is unavailable. <a href="#">Link</a>
<b>Discovery</b> <b>(WBCEA)</b>	4 & 5 - years 7-10. some stage 6 Year 11 & 12	This curriculum consists of 8 lessons per term, however, lessons can easily be shortened or drawn out.	The discovery Curriculum places a high level of responsivity on the teacher to design lessons that are appropriate for their context. The curriculum provides a framework, outline and rational for the SRE lessons. Each teacher must then build their lessons accordingly.	PowerPoint slides, lesson plans or class worksheets are not provided.  However, teachers already using the Discovery Curriculum can be contacted.	A useful curriculum when teachers are wanting to develop lessons appropriate for their context. The Discovery curriculum provides a framework and guidance for lesson content with plenty of creativity left to the actual teacher. Another strength of this curriculum is that it does not assume any prior Biblical knowledge or literacy. This curriculum has also appropriately made use of Youth Alpha.</p>	<p>PowerPoints, Videos, lesson outlines, and web links are all included.</p>	<p>A great curriculum for teachers who want detailed and varied lessons. Lessons can be covered in just one session or over a couple, depending on the length of SRE class time. Videos range from 20 – 30 minutes but do allow time for hitting pause.	Video based learning with time for classroom conversation and Bible verses to explore.	The Curriculum comes with detailed teaching notes, and worksheets. This includes worksheets where Bibles are not available as well as worksheets for when Bibles are available.	Time should be taken by the SRE teachers to first watch the video content. 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<b>PeaceWise Youth</b>	Stage 4 & 5 - years 7-10.  - Stage 5 could be used for stage 6	PeaceWise Youth is a detailed program that will teach students how to engage conflict in a healthy way.  PeaceWise youth is full of Biblical principles but is largely a welfare-based teaching program. There are bible references so SRE teachers can dive deeper into the scriptures.	15 Lessons per stage.  Video bases learning with teacher facilitation.	PeaceWise Youth is full of detailed lesson plans, short clips and class handouts.	Loads of material – in fact the challenge will be whether or not SRE teachers will be able to work through all the content. Doing so would easily require 2 school terms of weekly lessons.
