SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

Topic Xp. Season 1

Duration 9 Lessons

Focus Students will consider the following questions:

1. Adventure: Why do we seek adventure?

2. Happiness: What does real happiness look like?

3. Real: What if we could be real?

4. Anxious?: What does hope look like?

5. Wonder: What happened to wonder

6. More: Is there more?

7. Special: Is life special?

8. Meaning: Why are we here?

9. Connection: Who are we here for?

UNDERSTANDING

Students will be able to

- Understand the web of cultural stories they're a part of (helpful and unhelpful)
- Explore how the Christian story meets our core human needs/longings/questions.
- ldentify key questions people raise about life and Christianity.
- Explain why people have these questions.
- Understand how Christian beliefs and scriptures intersect with these life questions.

ACQUISITION

Students will learn that Christians believe that:

- There is a deeper story to life worth exploring
- That story is found in the Bible

SKILLS

Students will be able to:

- Use critical thinking to reflect on the reasons Christians believe what they believe
- Deepen their understanding of their own worldview and it's intersection with Christian belief and teaching
- Weigh up Christian response to common life questions and assess the plausibility of these responses

RELATING TO GOD

Students will understand that:

- Christians believe that our core human longings for meaning, identity and belonging are met in a relationship with God
- Christians believe that our core human questions invite us to explore a deeper connection with God
- Christians believe that the Christian story has answers to life's biggest questions
- Christians believe that God is not just our ultimate why, but our ultimate 'who'

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RELATING TO OTHERS

Students will understand that:

- Christians believe that happiness is found in serving others sacrificially
- Christians believe that love from God allows us to be loved and known
- Christians believe that the world is special, and that invites Christians to live differently in the world around them
- Christians believe that the world is created for deep relational connection because it reflects the deep relationality of the Christian God.

RELATING TO THE WORLD

Students will understand that:

- Christians believe that God is the creator of the world
- Christians believe that Christianity provides practical resources to live a life of joy, hope, meaning, purpose and connection.
